### Ways to help your child at home:

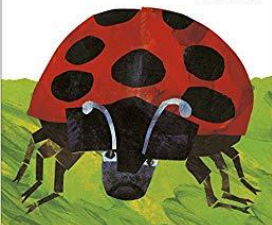
- Ensure all homework is completed.
