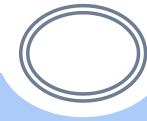

- Overseeing Financial performance

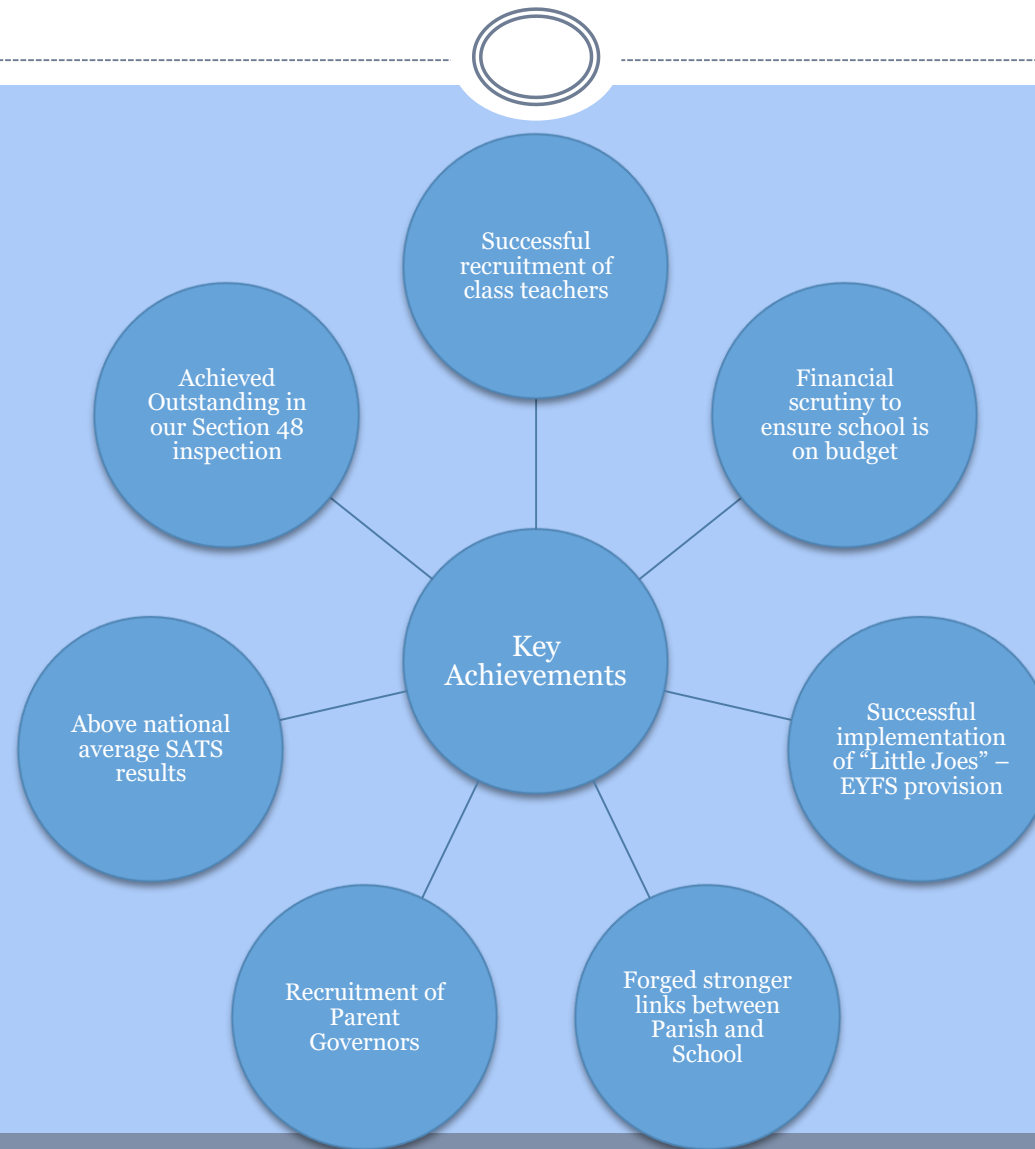
At St. Joseph's we have 2 committees:
