*The Ten Commandments are the word of God, regarded in the Old Testament as a gift and sign of God's love. They express the implications of belonging to God through the covenant of Sinai. Jesus summed them up saying, "This is the first and greatest commandment: You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. The second is this: You shall love your neighbour as yourself." (RECD p.35)*

## **Key Learning Objectives**

In this unit the children will have the opportunity to:

Know that God loves us and calls us into a relationship with Him

- Learn that God gave Moses the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai because He loves us
- Understand that the Ten Commandments are a gift from God to help us
- Know how Jesus summarised the Ten Commandments (**Mt.22:36-40**)
- Understand how we can show our love for God by keeping His commandments with His help and grace
- Remember that God sent his Son Jesus into the world because He loves us
- Appreciate how God has shown His love for us
- Think about ways that we can deepen our relationship with God

- talking to them about how we try to live by the Ten Commandments.
