#### <u>Literacy:</u>

In literacy this half term we will be exploring different text styles about celebrations ranging from poems, songs, traditional tales, fiction and non-fiction stories. We will be looking at poems about remembrance and Christmas before creating our own poems. We will also be looking at fiction and non-fiction books about celebrations from around the world such as 'The best Diwali ever' and 'Lets celebrate'.

## Religious Education

This term we are going to be learning about God's Family. In this topic, we will be learning: That God made all the people in the world to be part of his family and that we are part of it too. That God made us to know and love him and to show our love for him by helping one another. That God's greatest gift to us was to send us his only son Jesus and respond to that gift.

# Maths

In maths this term, we will be learning all about numbers 1 and 2. The children will learn to recognise when there are 1 or 2 objects in a set without counting them as well as match the objects to the corresponding numeral. Children will also learn about AB patterns and identify how the patterns are made before being able to predict what comes next. They will also begin to identify and correct when a pattern is incorrect.

# Learning Challenge

Our topic for this half term is 'celebrations'.

As such, each week the children will be learning about a different celebration from around the world, why that celebration is special, who celebrates that particular celebration and how it is celebrated.

We will be learning to value and respect the cultures and traditions of people from around the world, explore, and take part in some of those celebrations.
