English

In English, we are reading "*The Tin Forest by Helen Ward*" We will explore this play using drama, Guided Reading and then complete different pieces of writing based around the text. The genres we are focusing on this term are short stories, imaginative pieces and play script. We will focus this term heavily on grammar and punctuation- using a variety of punctuation marks including full stops, commas, exclamation marks, question marks brackets and colons

Maths

In Maths, we will focus on multiplication and division. Pupils will learn the times table and their inverses. They will learn how to read and write arrays and do repeated additions. The pupils will continue to do reasoning and problem solving activities to ensure they develop the skills to solve problems later in life.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about Forces and Magnets. Pupils will be carrying out several investigations and experiments and magnetic and non- magnetic materials. They will develop an understanding magnetic pull and why they occur.

Learning Challenge

During this half term, our learning will alternate to Geography which will consist of learning about the Countries around the world, in which we will identify, describe and locate key:, countries, regions, cities and Towns. We will also do a local study in History, about Wandsworth. We will explore different parks and other areas of interest in the borough.
