Key Learning Objectives

In this unit the children will have the opportunity to:

- Know what happened at the Last Supper
- Reflect on how the Mass makes this real for us
- Understand what happens at the beginning of Mass
- Think about why we say 'sorry'
- Understand the importance of the Readings at Mass
- Reflect on how we listen to God's Word
- Know what happens at the Offertory and the Consecration
- Think about the offerings we can make
- Know that it is Jesus we receive in Holy Communion
- Reflect on this very great gift
- Reflect on the importance of our Parish Church
