This half term your child will be studying the topic of New Life:



Key Learning Objectives

In this unit the children will have the opportunity to:

- Begin to understand that Jesus rose from the dead
- Experience Easter joy through a celebration using music, drama or dance
- Learn the story of the disciples discovering the empty tomb (John 20) and know that Jesus appeared to the disciples
- Think about why these stories are important
- Begin to understand the special gift of joy and peace that Jesus gave to the disciples (John 20: 19-21) and can give to us
- Hear the story of Jesus going back to His Father in heaven and that one day we can go there



At Home:

You could help your child by:

- Talking about how Jesus' empty tomb was discovered and help them to become more familiar with this special story.
- Looking for signs of new life
- Practising the Sign of the Cross, the 'Our Father and the 'Hail Mary'
