
(Summer term, first half 2024)

This half term your child will be studying the topic of The Resurrection:

Catechism of the Catholic Church "*Jesus Christ's Resurrection – and the risen Christ himself – is the principle and source of our future resurrection: 'Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep... For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.'*"

Key Learning Objectives

In this unit the children will have the opportunity to:



- Know that Jesus appeared to the disciples in the Upper Room and think about the times when we have experienced great joy and surprise
- Learn that Jesus helped the disciples to understand that He was truly risen and was with them (John 21:9-14) and this made them very happy
- Know that when Thomas heard that Jesus was alive, he did not believe it
- Be aware that sometimes like Thomas, we don't understand what is happening

At Home:

You might like to discuss with you child what happened to Jesus after He rose from the dead. Think about the disciples' reaction to the news that He had risen and how Jesus helped them to understand what had happened.
