Key Learning Objectives

In this unit the children will have the opportunity to:

- Begin to understand what being a Christian involves
- Reflect on what it means for us
- Know what Jesus teaches about helping others
- Reflect on how we help others
- Know how St Paul had to learn to be a Christian
- Think about what we can learn from his experience
- Know that the Sacraments are a meeting with Jesus
- Be aware that in the Sacraments we receive Jesus' great love
- Know about how people use their gifts to help others
- Think about what we can learn from them
- Begin to understand the importance of prayer and think about different ways of praying

At Home:

You might like to talk to your child about what it means to be a Christian. Discuss together the story of the Good Samaritan and think about what this story is telling us. You could also research the lives of St Peter and St Paul, thinking about the journey that each man went through.
