Key Learning Objectives

- Understand that the Spirit of Jesus works in many ways and reflect on the Spirit at work in the Church
- Know that Jesus is present among us in different ways and reflect on how we can be present with Jesus
- Learn that there are different ways of praying and explore some of them
- Understand how Jesus teaches us to pray and reflect on the importance of prayer for us

This half term, the children will be learning about different types of prayer. You might like to research some of these with them at home. Discuss with your child the importance of prayer and how it can make a difference in our lives.
