<u>Literacy:</u>

In literacy this term we will be focusing on describing the setting, main characters and events that happen in the story, we will begin to encourage children to make suggestions about what might happen next and recall parts of the story that they have remembered and found interesting.

We will also be focusing on developing our control of one-handed tools such as pencils, to form shapes, letters and pictures with accuracy.

Maths

In maths this term, we will be focusing on identifying, representing and subitising number 6, we will also begin to develop the children's mathematical language to sort and compare objects according to height, length, weight and capacity.

RE

In RE this term, we will be learning about Joy and Sorrow. We will be exploring different ways to be kind to our friends, teachers and loved ones and how to say sorry when we make a mistake or do something wrong. We will also learn about the Story of Zacchaeus and the joy and sorrow that Jesus's friends experience at his death and resurrection through the teachings of the Easter story.

Learning Challenge

Our topic this term is people who help us. As such, we will be learning about people who help us at school. People who help we safe and people who help keep us safe and people who help keep us healthy. We will also be discussing with children the difference between safe strangers and unsafe strangers as well as talking about what we want to be when we grow up.
